Tech-Talk on AI and the EU Labour Market

Invitation

We would like to invite you to our **Tech-Talk on “AI and the Labour Market: Where does this leave diverse and inclusive labour markets?”** at 4.30–5.30 p.m. on 7 December 2021.

We are in the mid of the digital transformation, which also affects the labour market. In relation to job seekers, digitalisation plays a role in how workers find jobs, but also in which jobs are made available to a job seeking worker. Algorithms play a central role in this process. They use data that is consciously, as well as unconsciously, produced by workers to match them with available positions, or to classify a worker as suitable or not for a job. Does the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) fully protect job seekers from this algorithmic matching? Are certain workers systematically discriminated against? What influence does this have on ensuring diverse and inclusive labour markets for generations to come? And what should be done to ensure workers' rights in the digital age?

With our Tech-Talk we would like – together with **Christina J. Colclough** (The Why Not Lab), **Jan P. Brauburger** (IndustriALL) and **tbc** (EDPS) – to seek solutions and ask what needs to be done on the European level to provide more transparency and rights to the workers.

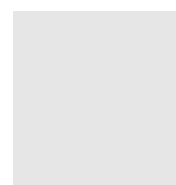
